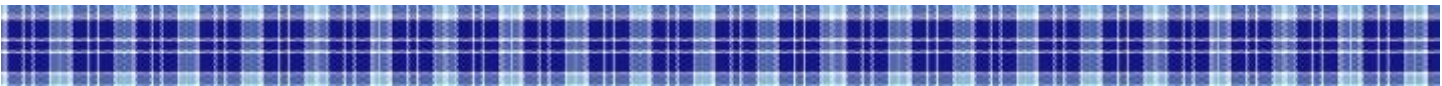
It's time to start thinking about holiday shopping! Use our school's Scrip program to buy gift cards as gifts or use them to do your shopping.

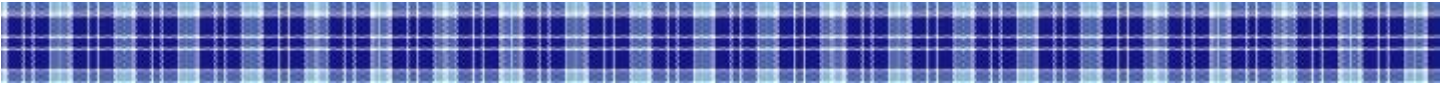


SOCKS FOR SENIORS COLLECTION NOV. 17 – DEC. 12
