

A registered parishioner rate is given to families who actively participate in the parish's ministerial activities, who regularly attend Mass, and who contribute to the parish (weekly/monthly) using the envelope system.

Families who receive the parishioner tuition rate are required to volunteer 25 hours of service to the School or Church of St. Mary. A non-contributing parishioner is expected to pay the same tuition rate as a non-parishioner.

Fees:

\$30 one-time pre-enrollment testing fee

\$150 re-enrollment fee – at re-enrollment in January

Home and School Fee - \$50/family - in July

Book Fee - \$85/student - in July

Technology Fee - \$35/family - In September

Cafeteria fee - \$200 unless family works one day per month in the cafeteria - at registration in August

Oil Pastels - \$2.50 (1st grade) - at registration in August

Recorder - \$5.00 (5th grade) - at registration in August
