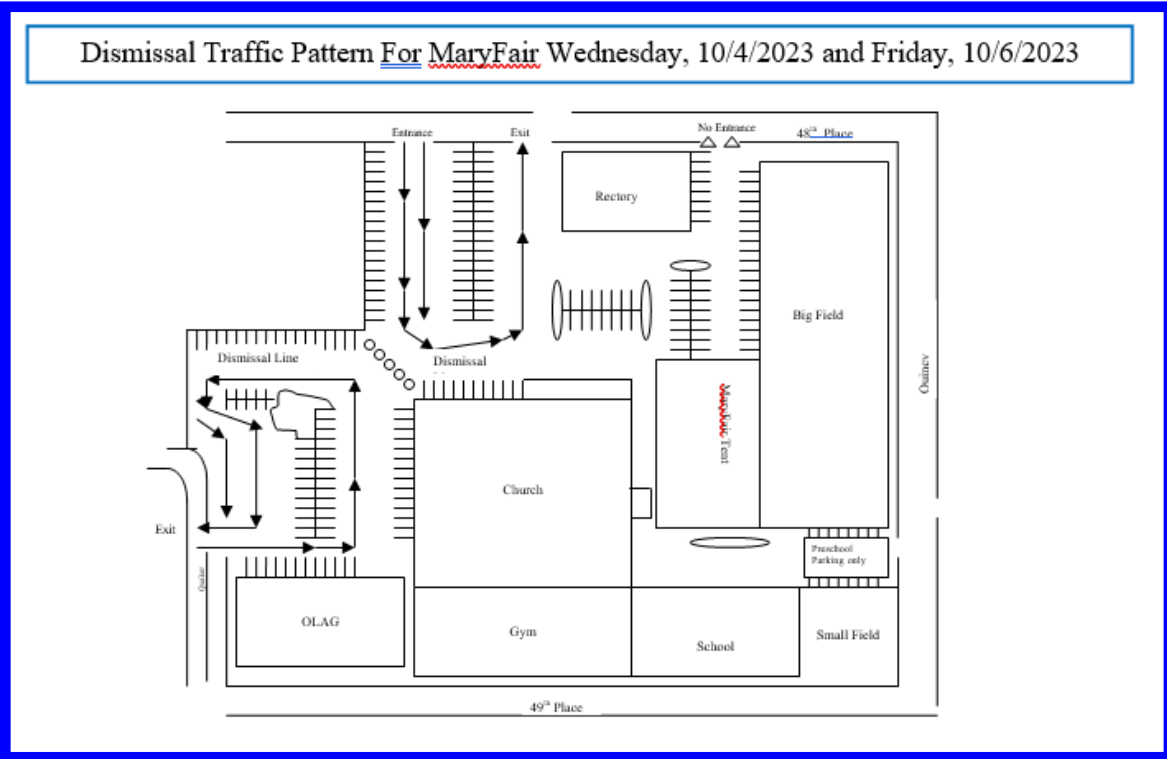
We are looking forward to seeing everyone at Parent/Teacher Conferences this evening and tomorrow morning. Don't forget that basketball sign ups will be available at conferences.

Announcements:

- **Parking next week:** MaryFair is October 7th and 8th. The giant MaryFair Tent will be put up on Wednesday, October 4th. **Because of this, pick-up after school for Wednesday, 10/4, Thursday, 10/5, and Friday, 10/6 will be adjusted** (drop-off should remain the same). The line by the rectory, exiting onto 48th Place will remain open, but the lines in the big parking lot will not be available. To help relieve the congestion caused by losing these exit lines, dismissal lines will be formed in the west parking lot. These **temporary** lines will exit onto Quaker. There will be teachers helping with traffic flow and a diagram of the exits for Wednesday, 10/3, Thursday, 10/4, and Friday 10/5, is attached to this FYI. **Students will be dismissed through the Beckerle door and lined up on west church side parking lot. You will still need to get your child from the teacher.**

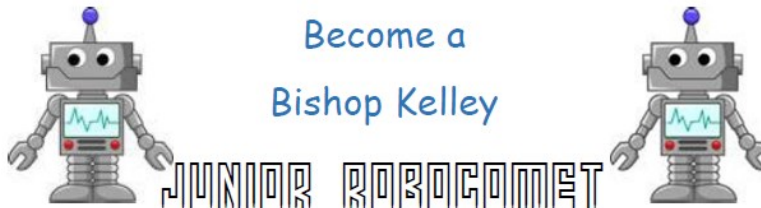

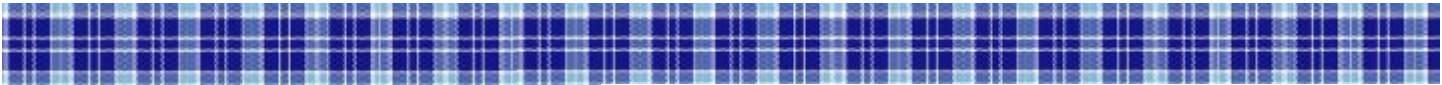
