Dear Saint Mary Families,

In anticipation of the December 1st opening of the portal to apply for the tuition tax credit and to have the necessary paperwork ready for our families who want to apply, the School of Saint Mary Advisory Council has set tuition for the 2024-25 school year. We realize this is very early, and want families to know that we have worked hard to anticipate our needs based on previous years' budget numbers. Leaders from our diocesan schools across the diocese have worked together to keep tuition increases as consistent as possible in all our schools. One of the biggest challenges, especially in this time of teacher shortage, is keeping compensation for our employees commensurate with schools across the state. The state of Oklahoma has provided substantial raises over the last year. Our advisory council members did an extensive comparison of School of Saint Mary salaries to those of other schools, Catholic as well as public, at it is those numbers that drove this increase.

The School of Saint Mary Advisory Council has approved a tuition increase of 5% for the 2024-25 school year. Our goal is always one of keeping tuition increases as minimal as possible. The objective of the budget process is to create a budget which will allow the School of Saint Mary to continue to be one of the best values in our city. The operational line items in the annual budget, except for salaries, taxes and insurance, have not increased.



It is our cherished role as adults to fully protect children. In addition, we must also teach children about their safety rights and boundaries, so that they have tools to protect themselves. This year, your child will experience one of the following age-appropriate lessons:

Empowering God's Children Program Information:

A program for children presented by Lesson Leaders, each lesson includes an age-appropriate video component along with engaging learning activities. The material is designed to better equip your child to know their safety rights, recognize their boundaries, and to empower them to protect themselves when safe adults are not immediately available—and ultimately be safer from people who might want to harm them.

Lesson 1: Physical Boundaries: Safe and Unsafe Touching Rules Lesson 4: Secrets, Surprises and Promises

Lesson 2: Safe Adults, Safe Touches and Special Safe Adults Lesson 5: Being a Safe Friend

Lesson 3: Boundaries: You Have Rights! Lesson 6: Boundaries: Feelings and Facts

Research shows that child sexual abuse prevention is most effective when there is a partnership between parents and Lesson Leaders, when material is reiterated in a school setting, and when the training is interactive and activity based. As the primary educators of your children, parents and guardians are encouraged to review these materials ahead of time.
