Happy New Year! It is indeed good to see all our families back from what was hopefully a restful and refreshing break. Being January it is necessary to mention inclement weather. Below is our Inclement Weather procedure, but I wanted to add a bit about how the decision is made. I am the person who has to make the decision as to whether or not the School of Saint Mary has school on inclement weather days because conditions can vary greatly from one part of town to another and because our ability to have effective virtual days is limited due to the age range of our students, this is always a difficult decision to make. I take into consideration what the other Catholic schools are doing, but more importantly what the surrounding districts are doing to best assess conditions in the part of town where the majority of our families live.

Inclement Weather Notification Procedure:

The principal or the principal's designate will make the decision if the School of Saint Mary will not be in session or will have a late start due to inclement weather. Information regarding inclement weather school closure or an altered start time will be sent via the school notification system as a text message and the information will also be posted on ParentSquare. Parents/ Guardians must assess the conditions in their specific area and use their best judgment regarding safe passage to and from school.
