## **Tuition Assistance**

Tuition assistance is available via GO for Catholic Education, the Saint Francis of Assisi Educational Trust, and Veritas. Please consider applying for tuition assistance via FACTs as a partner to the tax credit. Unless a family was previously in the priority category (Adjusted Gross Income under \$150,000) and is still in the priority category, receipt of the tax credit in 2024-25 does not guarantee a family will be awarded it again for 2025-26.

The School of Saint Mary has a significant amount of tuition assistance that can be awarded, but families must apply through FACTs. The FACTs application window is open now and will remain open through April 15, 2025.
