Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance is available via GO for Catholic Education, the Saint Francis of Assisi Educational Trust, and Veritas. Please consider applying for tuition assistance via FACTs as a partner to the tax credit. Unless a family was previously in the priority category (Adjusted Gross Income under \$150,000) and is still in the priority category, receipt of the tax credit in 2024-25 does not guarantee a family will be awarded it again for 2025-26.

The School of Saint Mary has a significant amount of tuition assistance that can be awarded, but families must apply through FACTs. The FACTs application window is open now and will remain open through April 15, 2025. If you have any questions regarding tuition assistance, please contact Mrs. Ames for preschool or Suzanne Nelson for school.
